THE PASTOR'S REPORT
2009 Annual Report

Grace be unto you and peace from our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ.

For two and a half months I have served as your interim pastor. It has been a good experience for me, and I have enjoyed preaching the Gospel and visiting among you. One of the things that struck me right away is that Pleasant View is a caring congregation. I am amazed at all the ministries that are carried out among you. The food pantry is a wonderful outreach into the community as well as serving meals to the hungry at Trinity Church and the Angel Tree. However, there are other ways that perhaps is seldom noticed like mailing bulletins to our shut-ins and visiting in their homes and bringing a meal to eat with them. Pleasant Memories gathers our older people for a time of fellowship and support. Also, you are striving to be a forgiving congregation and acceptance of all who come to worship with you. I want to encourage you in your various ministries and thank God for your efforts.

For my part I have visited in some fifty-five homes and will continue that visitation after Christmas. I find that as I visit with you, we get acquainted and share common concerns. We become sensitive to each others feelings and can better work together for the good of the church.

With Council's approval, several new initiatives have been started or will start soon. Perhaps one of the most important is the establishment of a Pastor's Relations Committee. The purpose of this committee is to give the congregation and pastor an arena in which openly and honestly concerns and ideas may be shared. The newsletter has also been started again in order that we can better communicate the happenings of the congregation. A group of "middle age" adults will meet soon to explore ways that this grouping may better support one another and the church. A youth director in the person of Judy Shuey has been installed to work directly with our young people. *Children's Time* in worship calls attention to the importance of our children, and Jesus' words that only as we become as a little child shall we enter the Kingdom of Heaven.

Some people have asked as to how long the interim will last. Hopefully, it will last until you are able with the synods help to call your own full time pastor. I know that this will take some time, and with the Lord's help, I am committed to stay with you.

Following the written report is some statistical information for my work the first two and a half months of my ministry with you.

His sermons come to us both as an inspiration and a lesson in learning the true meaning of the Gospel. The council wishes to thank the congregation for their support of Pastor Price and the 'can do' attitude needed to perform the tasks necessary to build a stronger faith foundation that will fan the intensity of our faith life at Pleasant View.

Congregational members should take time to read the words of encouragement from Pastor Price's 2009 annual report. We should be looking to ourselves with the help of God to step up to the commitment to grow in faith in support of Pastor Price's words of encouragement. The Stewardship and Finance Committee, which consisted of eight members, met several times during 2009 to accomplish the responsibilities of this committee as outlined in the Church Constitution and By-Laws.

The annual budget for 2010 was prepared, presented, and approved by the Church Council. The budget was presented and approved by the congregation at the Annual Meeting on November 15, 2009. The budget approved for 2010 was \$132,635.00, which is a decrease of \$21,336.00, compared to the 2009 budget of \$153,971.00.

During the year several dedicated volunteers assisted Carol Troxell, Financial Secretary, each Sunday morning with the counting and recording of offerings and contributions. These volunteers were Becky Paige, Paula Staley, Hunter Fauber, Gene Lilly, Burke Simmons and Fred Bowers.
