***Sharing the Faith: Roots & Wings*** is a ministry of the Virginia Synod. **Its theme is “Nurturing Faith ... Every Day in Every Way!”** Each month a calendar is published with ideas for family time for each day. These ideas on the calendar are chosen in relationship to the four keys associated with *Roots and Wings*: caring conversation, rituals and traditions, devotional practices, and services.

Each week a small lesson from one of the Bible passages, the Gospel Acclamation which could be used as a memory verse for the week, some ideas for conversations or activities, and a coloring page. Our WELCA and Education Committee have adopted a service project in support of Minnick Schools in our Synod. We will be collecting kitchen supplies (paper plates and cups, napkins, and plastic utensils) during July. Two meals are served to students during each school day. Boxes are in the Narthex and Social Hallway.

Minnick Schools "offer school-aged children the opportunity to take a different path. Highly trained educators and treatment specialists help students learn about behavior choices, how to make better decisions, and how to respond to stressful and challenging situations. Six Minnick Schools help students age 5 to 22 find success in the classroom. They work with public schools in the Harrisonburg, Roanoke, Wytheville, Wise and Bristol regions to help their students achieve academic, behavioral and developmental goals so they may return to their home public school or pursue a path to meaningful work."
